ORDINANCE NO. 58

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MIDWAY CITY SANITARY DISTRICT OF ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING METHOD FOR BILLING SANITATION AND SEWER SERVICE CHARGES FOR AREA NO. 141 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1997

WHEREAS, the District has established rates for wastewater collection, treatment and disposal services and facilities for Area 141 under Ordinance No. 57; and

WHEREAS, the District has established rates for trash collection and disposal services and facilities for Area 141 under Ordinance No. 57; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to establish a method for the billing of services provided to Area 141; and

WHEREAS, the District has considered the benefits of using the property tax statement to levy sanitation and sewer charges on each lot or parcel in Area 141 that receives services from the District for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1997 in lieu of the other billing methods; and

WHEREAS, the authority to collect sanitation and sewer service charges on the property tax statement is provided in State of California Health and Safety Code Section

5473, et seq.; and

 WHEREAS, the District has evaluated various alternatives for collecting sewer service charges which include conversion to monthly billing; and

WHEREAS, Board of Directors has caused the preparation of a report proposing each parcel in Area 141 to be subject to sanitation and sewer service charges and the amount of charges applicable thereto (the "Engineer's Report"), which is incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 5473.1, the District has notified all property owners within the Area 141 of the proposed method of collection has published notice of a hearing with respect thereto in a newspaper of general circulation;

 NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Midway City Sanitary District does hereby ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1. Charges

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 5471, the sanitation and sewer service charges set forth by District Ordinance No. 57, as the same may be amended from time to time (the "Rates"), shall be collected for the provision of sanitation and wastewater collection, treatment and disposal services by the District.

Section 2. Levy

The General Manager is hereby directed to take all necessary action to submit the Rates for the applicable fiscal year to the Auditor and Tax Collector of Orange County in the amounts for each parcel as delineated in the aforementioned Engineer's Report.

Section 3. Collection

The Tax Collector of the County of Orange is hereby directed to levy, collect and remit to the District the Rates at the time and in the manner required by law for the levying of taxes for County purposes.

Section 4. Annual Report and Hearing

On an annual basis, the General Manager is hereby directed to cause preparation of an Engineer's Report, which shall be for each year a written report of the parcels subject to sanitation and sewer service charges and the charge applicable to each. The annual report shall be submitted to the County Auditor.

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 5473.1, the General Manager shall cause notice of filing of the annual Engineer's Report to be published indicating the time and place for a hearing thereon before the District's Board of Directors.

Section 5. Exemption

Notwithstanding the above, the following parcels may be exempted from the method of collection stated herein.

- B. Parcels that receive sanitation or sewer service for which the General Manager, in his discretion, finds that a hardship will be created for the property owner by collection of service charges via the property tax statement.
- C. Parcels otherwise subject to exemption of fees and charges by other District ordinances.

The General Manager shall establish and make available to interested applicants procedures for filing and consideration of applications for exemption from the method of collection stated herein.

The General Manager is further directed to review any such applications for exemption to determine whether or not the property owners situation qualifies for exemption and allow or disallow such applications based upon those guidelines. The General Manager shall also establish reasonable procedures for the filing and timing of the appeals from his determination.

The Board of Directors shall hear all appeals from determinations by the General Manager to deny or qualify an application for exemption. Board shall act upon such recommendations and its decision as to such appeals shall be final.

Section 6. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application to any person or circumstance is held invalid by order of court, the remainder of the Ordinance or the application of such provision to other persons or other circumstances shall not be affected.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall become effective on June 28,1997. The Secretary of the Board shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause a summary of the same to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the District, as required by law.
