AN ORDINANCE OF THE MIDWAY CITY SANITARY DISTRICT OF ORANGE COUNTY CALIFORNIA. REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 24, 30, AND 49; ESTABLISHING SERVICE CHARGES FOR TRASH AND SEWER SERVICES; ELECTING TO HAVE SAID CHARGES COLLECTED ON THE TAX ROLLS; DIRECTING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO PREPARE AND FILE A REPORT OF SAID CHARGES; AND DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF THE DISTRICT TO PUBLISH NOTICE OF THE FILING OF THE REPORT

The Board of Directors of the Midway City Sanitary District of Orange County, California, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance Nos. 24, 30 and 49 of the Midway City Sanitary District of Orange County, California are hereby repealed.

Section 2: Pursuant to the provisions of Health and Safety Code Section 5471, the following service charges are hereby established:

- A. For each residential unit or separate commercial or industrial unit or activity connected to the sewer service facilities of the District, a sewer service charge not to exceed the sum of One Dollar and 25/100 (\$1.25) per unit of activity per month.
- B. For each residential unit or separate commercial or industrial unit or activity not utilizing a Bin Service Program, a trash collection fee not to exceed the sum of Six Dollars and 75/100 (\$6.75) per unit of activity per month. This charge shall be payable by the property owner whether or not such owner utilizes the District refuse collection service.

Section 3: Pursuant to the provisions of Health and Safety Code Section 5473, the Board of Directors hereby elects to continue to have said service charges collected on the tax roll in the same manner, by the same persons, and at the same time as, together with and not separately from, the general taxes of the District.

Section 4: The Manager of the District shall cause a written report to be prepared and filed with the Secretary of the Board, which reports shall contain a description of each parcel of real property receiving such services and facilities and the amount of the charge for each parcel for the year, computed in conformity with the charges prescribed above.

Section 5: The Secretary of the Board shall cause notice of the filing of the report and of the time and place of hearing thereon to be published in accordance with Health and Safety Code Section 5473.1.

Section 6: That the Secretary of the District shall cause publication of this Ordinance, along with the names of those Board members voting for and against the Ordinance, once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the District, and a certified copy of this Ordinance along with the names of those Board members voting for and against the Ordinance, shall be posted in the office of the Manager of the District.
