ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MIDWAY CITY SANITARY DISTRICT, OF ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING CONNECTION FEES; AND REPEALING SECTION 2-J OF RESOLUTION NO. 516, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS INCONSISTENT HEREWITH TO THE EXTENT OF SUCH INCONSISTENCY.

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MIDWAY CITY SANITARY DISTRICT, of Orange County, California, does ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1: No person shall cause any building or other structure to be directly or indirectly connected to the sewerage facilities of the District unless as to such connection there has been payment of the connection fees as set forth herein and such other connection fees as the District may from time to time provide.

Section 2: No person shall make an original direct connection into the sewerage facilities of the District without first obtaining a permit therefor from the District.

Section 3: Each owner of property improving vacant or unimproved property or causing the use of any existing structure, or portion thereof, to be changed, or causing any structure, or portion thereof, to be enlarged or directly or indirectly connected to the sewerage facilities of the District, shall pay to the District a Usage Charge as follows:

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Section 4: All connections shall be made at the sole expense of the property owner, subject to the approval and under the supervision and inspection of the District Inspector.

Section 5: This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Health and Safety Code Sections 5474 and 6520.2. The rates and charges established hereby, if not paid, shall be collected on the next ensuing tax roll, in the same manner and together with the general taxes of the District as provided for in Article 4, Chapter 6, Part 3, Division 5 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California. Any person violating the provisions hereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 6: That Section 2-J of Resolution No. 516 of this District be and the same hereby is repealed, and that all other resolutions and ordinances, and parts thereof, of this District inconsistent herewith be and the same hereby are

repealed to the extent of such inconsistency and no further.

Section 7: The Secretary of the District is hereby authorized and directed to cause a copy of this Ordinance to be published in a newspaper of general circulation and to be posted in three public places within the District.
