AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF MIDWAY CITY SANITARY DISTRICT OF ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF ALL PERSONS, PARTIES, ENTITIES OR CORPORATIONS WHOSE BUSINESS IS THE COLLECTION OF TRASH, REFUSE, RUBBISH AND GARBAGE WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MIDWAY CITY SANITARY DISTRICT

At a regular meeting held on August 4, 1987, on motion of Board Member Director Wiles, seconded by Board Member Director Nelson, it was ordered that the following General Regulation Ordinance be and the same is hereby adopted, to-wit:

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Midway City Sanitary District to promote the most efficient and cleanly operation possible in the collection of trash, refuse, rubbish and garbage; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Midway City Sanitary District to insure that each resident within the boundaries of the District is provided with the best service in the collection of trash, refuse, rubbish and garbage with the maximum amount of protection possible to each such resident; and

WHEREAS, there are now numerous trash contractors doing business within the Midway City Sanitary District whose services are not at this time subject to license or regulation by Resolution of the Midway City Sanitary District.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of Midway City Sanitary District does hereby RESOLVE that General Regulation Ordinance No. 38 is hereby set forth as follows:

Section 1: Purpose. The purpose of Article I of this Ordinance is to provide revenue for the general operation of the Midway City Sanitary District by a levy of a license fee on any and all persons, parties, entities or corporations whose business is the collection of trash, garbage, rubbish or refuse within the boundaries of the Midway City Sanitary District. Article I of this Ordinance is not intended in any manner for the regulation of such persons, parties, entities or corporations.

ARTICLE I

There is hereby imposed Section 2: License Required. upon any party, person, entity or corporation whose business is the collection of trash, rubbish, garbage or refuse within the boundaries of the Midway City Sanitary District an annual license fee in the amount hereinafter prescribed:

- Α. Any person, persons, entity or corporation operating one trash collecting vehicle within the Midway City Sanitary District - Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00);
- B. For any person, persons, entity or corporation operating more than one trash collecting vehicle within the boundaries of the Midway City Sanitary District - Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for the first trash collecting vehicle and Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per vehicle for the next five (5) trash collecting vehicles and Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each trash collecting vehicle over six (6).

Section 3: Violation. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, entity or corporation to transact and carry on the

business of collecting trash, refuse, rubbish and garbage within the boundaries of the Midway City Sanitary District without first having procured a license from said Midway City Sanitary District to do so or without complying with any and all applicable provisions of this Article. A violation of this Ordinance is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) imprisonment not to exceed one (1) month, or both. A separate violation will be deemed to have occurred for each day or part of a day thereof that such person, persons, entity or corporation conducts business within the Midway City Sanitary District without first having procured the license as aforementioned.

<u>Section 4:</u> <u>License Application.</u> Before any license is issued, applicant shall make a written application to the **Midway**City Sanitary District requesting the issuance of a license. Such application shall be provided by the District and shall be completed by the applicant prior to the issuance of a license.

If, upon completing the application and it appears from the information received that applicant is in violation of any regulation or Ordinance of the District, then said District shall withhold issuance of a license until applicant provides proof that he will not be in violation of any Ordinance or regulation of the District upon commencing business within the boundaries of said District.

Section 5: License Non-Transferable. No license issued pursuant to this Section shall be transferable provided that when a license is issued authorizing a person, persons, entity or corporation to transact and carry on the business of collecting

garbage, trash, rubbish and refuse such license may, upon application, and paying any fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00), be amended to authorize the transacting and carrying on of business by the person, persons, entity or corporation subscribed onto said license by amendment.

Section 6: Term. All licenses shall be for a period of one (1) year beginning January 1 and ending December 31. All new licenses shall be for the period of time remaining in the current year of issue. New license fees shall be prorated for the time remaining in the calendar year.

ARTICLE II

Section 1: Purpose. The purpose of Article II of this Ordinance is to provide regulations for all persons collecting or depositing trash, refuse, rubbish and garbage within the Midway City Sanitary District pursuant to the California Health and Safety Code insuring the prompt and efficient removal of garbage, trash, rubbish and refuse and to protect the public health and promote the cleanliness of the roads, streets and areas within the Midway City Sanitary District.

Section 2: Violation. The violation of any regulation under this Article shall be punishable as a misdemeanor punishable by fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months, or both. A separate violation shall be deemed to exist for each day or part of a day thereof wherein and whereby such person, persons, entity or corporation fails to comply with the regulations as set forth herein.

Section 3: Regulations. The Midway City Sanitary District hereby sets forth the following regulations to apply to all

those persons, entities and corporations doing business within the Midway City Sanitary District or residing therein who deposit or collect trash, garbage, rubbish and refuse:

- Α. Every person doing business within the Midway City Sanitary District for the purpose of collecting garbage, trash, rubbish and refuse shall be adequately covered by public liability insurance. For the purpose of this Ordinance adequate public liability insurance shall be defined to mean a minimum of \$100,000.00 -\$500,000.00 public liability coverage and \$25,000.00 property damage coverage with the Midway City Sanitary District named as an additional insured on the policy of insurance. That every person doing business within the Midway City Sanitary District as aforesaid shall furnish the District with a certificate of insurance showing said District as an additional named insured on the policy of insurance. Such certificate must be on file at the office of the Midway City Sanitary District within thirty (30) days after application has been made for a license.
- B. Every person, persons, entity or corporation doing business within the Midway City Sanitary District for the purpose of collecting garbage, trash, rubbish and refuse shall use trash collecting vehicles with steelenclosed bodies.
- C. Every person, persons, entity or corporation doing business in the Midway City Sanitary District for the

purposes of collecting garbage, refuse, rubbish and trash shall mark each vehicle and trash bin with the name, address and telephone number of the person, persons, entity or company under which such business is conducted and shall mark each trash bin or receptacle with clearly legible notice prohibiting the discharge of hazardous materials.

- D. Every person, persons, entity or corporation doing business within the Midway City Sanitary District for the purposes of collecting trash, refuse, rubbish and garbage shall, on a quarterly basis to-wit: January 1, April 1, July 1 and October 1 of each year, submit to the District a written list of each and every person, or entity from whom said person, persons, entity or corporation is collecting trash, refuse, rubbish and garbage within the boundaries of the Midway City Sanitary District.
- E. Every person, persons, entity or corporation maintaining or using equipment within the boundaries of the Midway City Sanitary District for the purposes of collecting or depositing trash, refuse, rubbish and garbage shall keep such equipment in good mechanical condition and in a neat and orderly manner.
- F. Every person, persons, entity or corporation doing business within the Midway City Sanitary District for the purposes of collecting trash, refuse, rubbish and garbage shall not bring garbage, trash, rubbish or refuse from without the County of Orange on the vehi-

cles collecting trash, refuse, rubbish or garbage within the District.

- Every person, persons, entity or corporation doing G. business within the Midway City Sanitary District for the purposes of collecting trash, garbage, rubbish and refuse shall after each collection insure that the immediate area around such collection is left in a clean, neat and orderly manner without any garbage, trash, rubbish or refuse left on the ground. event said District, by or through its agents, determines that such person, persons, entity or corporation has not left the area of collection in a neat, orderly and cleanly manner then said District shall, after four hours' notice to such person, persons, entity or corporation cause said collection area to be cleaned and placed in proper order. The cost of cleaning and placing said collection area in proper order shall be determined by the District and billed to the person, persons, entity or corporation failing to comply with this regulation. Non-payment of such bill within ten (10) days after mailing shall be sufficient cause for said District to revoke any and all rights and privileges to do business within the boundaries of the Midway City Sanitary District.
- H. Every person, persons, entity or corporation doing business within the Midway City Sanitary District for the purpose of collecting trash, garbage, rubbish and

refuse and every person, persons, entity or corporation depositing trash, garbage, rubbish and refuse shall provide or have provided sufficient bins and/or receptacles to insure that between each collection of said garbage, trash, rubbish and refuse there shall not be deposited in said bin or receptacle garbage that will exceed the height of the top of such bin or receptacle.

I. Any bin or receptacle in which garbage or food residue is deposited, with the exception of residential "Rent-A-Bins" and Drop Boxes, which are not capable of being covered, shall be provided with a lid to cover said bin or receptacle. Such lid shall be kept on said bin or receptacle at all times and shall be replaced on said bin or receptacle by such person, persons, entity or corporation collecting such garbage or food residue after each collection. The word "garbage" shall include table refuse, swill and every accumulation of animal, vegetable and other matter that attends preparation, consumption, decay, dealing in or storage of meats, fish, fowl, fruits and vegetables or other food and shall include all animal and vegetable refuse from kitchens and all household waste from or intended as use as food and all vegetable trimmings from restaurants, markets or stores.

<u>Section 4:</u> Faithful Performance Bond. Every person, persons, entity or corporation doing business within the **Midway**City Sanitary District for the purposes of collecting trash, garbage, rubbish and refuse shall post with the District a surety bond

in the penal sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) conditioned upon the faithful performance of such person, persons, entity or corporation in complying with all regulations of the **District** and to insure that the **District** will suffer no loss by reason of noncombiance by such person, persons, entity or corporation necessitating action by the **District** to collect and/or clean and maintain a collection area by reason of non-compliance with these regulations.

ARTICLE III

Section 1: Purpose. The purpose of Article III of this Ordinance is to provide the District with the necessary police power to insure that any and all exclusive franchise agreements heretofore or hereafter entered into by the District shall not be infringed upon by any person, persons, entity or corporation.

Section 2: Violation. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, entity or corporation to collect any garbage, trash, rubbish and refuse from any source or particular location whatsoever while there is in existence an exclusive franchise agreement or grant by the Midway City Sanitary District to a person, persons, entity or corporation to collect all garbage, trash, rubbish and refuse from such source or location.

Section 3: Punishment. Every person, persons, entity or corporation who violates or infringes upon any exclusive franchise agreement or grant as heretofore set forth shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months, or both. A separate violation will be deemed to exist for

each day or part of a day thereof wherein and whereby such person, persons, entity or corporation violates or infringes upon such exclusive agreement or grant.

ARTICLE IV

Section 1: Exceptions. The Board of Directors of the Midway City Sanitary District may, upon good cause being shown, grant variances from any of the provisions of this General License and Regulation Ordinance and may reduce or eliminate any of the charges and/or fees referred to herein upon the finding that unusual circumstances exist which would result in undue hardship or unfairness to any particular person, persons, entity or corporation where the Board finds that it would be in the best interest of the District to waive any part or all of such charges and/or fees.

Section 2: Termination of Right to do Business Within the District. Not withstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, the District may terminate the license and right to do business within the boundaries of the Midway City Sanitary District for the purposes of collecting trash, rubbish, refuse and garbage upon a finding by the Board of Directors of said District or a conviction in a court of law that such person, persons, entity or corporation is in violation of any regulation or Ordinance of said District.

Prior to the termination of the right to do business, said District shall notify, in writing, such person, persons, entity or corporation of such intended termination. Such notice shall be mailed to the last known address of such person, persons, entity or corporation on the records of the District. The notice shall state the date of proposed termination of right to do business and the

reason therefor and the date the **District** Board shall hold a hearing of such intended termination. Such hearing shall not be held less than ten (10) days subsequent to the giving of notice as provided herein.

<u>Section 3:</u> This is a general regulation as described under Section 6490 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California and shall be published in <u>The Orange County Register</u>, a newspaper published in this district, and shall take effect upon the expiration of one (1) week after publication.
